Mississippi Psychological Association's 2019 Awards are to be presented at the Membership Breakfast Friday, September 27th during the annual convention, at the IP Casino Resort Spa in Biloxi, MS. Please consider the categories below, and submit your nominations, along with a short synopsis explaining for your nomination. **Please also indicate whether you will be available to present the award, should your nominee be chosen.**

Deadline for nominations is August 28, 2019

Distinguished Teaching of Psychology Award:

This award is presented to the MPA member who, over a period of time, has demonstrated outstanding performance as a university, college or internship teacher.

Distinguished Scientific Contribution Award:

This award is presented to MPA member, who, over a period of time, has demonstrated sustained productivity of superior and significant scientific research in psychology.

Distinguished Legislative Achievement Award:

This award is presented to Mississippi State of Federal legislators who have demonstrated significant commitment to issues of importance to psychology, mental health or human service legislation.

Outstanding Early Career Psychologist Award:

This award is presented to MPA member who has been working in the field for six years or less who has shown outstanding dedication and made notable contributions in the area of science, teaching, association activities or practice.

Kinloch Gill Award:

The Kinloch Gill Award is presented to the MPA member who has demonstrated excellence and distinction in contributions and service in the area of public interest and public service activities. Psychologists may be recognized for professional contributions which significantly benefit the public or special populations such as disadvantaged, chronically mentally ill or minority groups.

Distinguished Practitioner Award:

This award is presented to the MPA member who has made distinguished and significant contributions in the area of practice. Contributions may include activities fostering the development of the profession of psychology through legislative, political, legal or other areas and/or significant accomplishments through local, state or national organizations.

MPA Humanitarian Award:

This award recognizes extraordinary humanitarian service by a psychologist or individual for professional or voluntary activities to help alleviate severe stress and restore psychological well-being to an individual, family or group of people in difficult circumstances or events such as, but not limited to a natural or person-induced disaster.
